

## Call for nominations for Pascua Yaqui Board of Election Supervisors

**Open now through Sept 30.**

The Pascua Yaqui Tribe is seeking tribal members to appoint to the Pascua Yaqui Board of Elections Supervisors.

The Board of Election Supervisors assists the Pascua Yaqui Tribe by helping to maintain a list of registered voters of the Tribe, by conducting all tribal general and special elections, by conducting the election of tribal council members, or for initiative, referendum and recall measures, and the resolution of disputes arising from tribal elections.

The Pascua Yaqui Tribal Council welcomes the enthusiastic participation of its members on the Board of Elections Supervisors.

**Authority:** Pascua Yaqui Tribal Code 2 PYTC § 4-3-10, et seq.

**Term of Service:** 4 years

### **Qualifications:**

The Board shall consist of a Chairman and six (6) members who shall be appointed by the Chairman of the Tribal Council with the concurrence of the Tribal Council. The six members of the Board shall be selected at large and shall be enrolled members of the Pascua Yaqui Tribe; however, the Chairman shall make every attempt to insure representation on the Election Board from New Pascua, Old Pascua, Marana, Guadalupe, and Barrio Libre. If members are not available from each traditional Yaqui community the Chairman may select members from any community where members are available.

The Chair and each member of the Board of Election Supervisors shall be members of the Pascua Yaqui Tribe, at least 21 years of age, and shall not have been convicted in any Federal or State Court of a felony, or of any crime involving deceit, fraud or misappropriation of funds, unless in the event of a felony conviction his or her voting rights have been legally restored, or unless the criminal conviction has been expunged.
