AHCCCS/ALTCS-Arizona Long Term Care—this program provides quality long term care services to financially and medically eligible tribal members at little or no cost.

Community Health Nurse— provides community health nursing services to individuals and families within the community. Assessments, case management, coordination of care, consultations, counseling, direct nursing services. escorting to medical appointments, home visits, hospital discharge planning, medication management, ongoing monitoring in home or in a care facility and referral services.

Community Health Representative- provides community health nursing services to individuals and families within the community. Coordination of care, escorting to medical appointments, home visits, medication management, ongoing monitoring in home or in a care facility and support care to families.

HIV/STI/Hepatitis C— Dispense condoms, female condoms, dams and lubricants.

We Care Program— provides homemaker services to tribally enrolled members who may not be eligible for other home health programs due to income guidelines, or where otherwise applying for services would endanger the loss of home and or property.

Services provided to enrolled community members and their families within Pima County through the Tucson Area Indian Health Service and in Maricopa Country through the Phoenix Area Indian Health Services.

Referrals accepted from health care providers, hospitals and other tribal programs.
