AHCCCS/ALTCS-Arizona Long Term Care—this program provides quality long term care services to financially and medically eligible tribal members at little or no cost.

Behavioral Health— Provides psychiatry and therapeutic care for mental health, substance abuse, domestic violence, in children and adults.

Community Health Nurses— provides community health nursing services to individuals and families within the community. Assessments, education, coordination of care, consultations, direct nursing services. escorting to medical appointments, home visits, hospital discharge planning medication management, ongoing monitoring in home or in a care facility and referral services.

Community Health Representatives- provides community health nursing services to individuals and families within the community. Coordination of care, escorting to medical appointments, home visits, medication management, ongoing monitoring in home or in a nursing facility, and support care to families.

Social Services— may provide emergency housing, food vouchers, low income energy assistance and burial services.



Services provided to enrolled community members and their families within Pima County through the Tucson Area Indian Health Service and in Maricopa Country through the Phoenix Area Indian Health Services.

Referrals accepted from health care providers, hospitals and other tribal programs.


