WHO IS COVERED FOR OPTICAL?

Eligible Pascua Yaqui Tribal Members, residing within Maricopa County; must have a current and completed Alternate Resource application (AHCCCS). Since funding is limited, members are required to utilize Alternate Resources such as Vision Service Program (VSP), private vision insurance and AHCCCS primarily. Co-pays will be the responsibility of the member when an alternate resource is available. If you choose to go to a provider of your choice, you will be responsible for the cost of those services.

HOW OFTEN CAN I RECEIVE OPTICAL SERVICES?

Optical services that include: Eye exam and glasses or contacts will only be authorized every **2** years.

HOW MUCH WILL IT COST?

The Yoeme Managed Care Program only covers the eye exam and select frames and lenses or contacts at the contract rate. Any additional costs will be your responsibility.
