



and the prosecutor's office. Trans. at 4. However, the statutory requirement of Section 3.9(B)(4) is the controlling law.

Accordingly, the notice of appeal is dismissed because the law on the time for the filing of a Juvenile Offender Petition is clear. In addition, the Appellee Juvenile's identity has been changed in the caption of this appeal for confidentiality reasons.


