

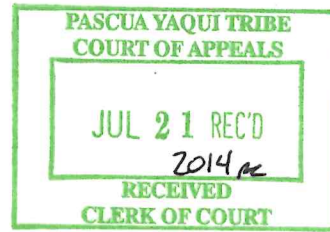

On July 16, 2014, the above-captioned matters came before this Court for a Status hearing. Yancy Jencsok was present on behalf of the Tribe. The Defendant was not present and his presence was waived. Defense counsel, Patricia Leon-Enriquez was present.

Mr. Jencsok informed the Court that the Defendant continues in federal custody and is awaiting a Sentencing hearing on September 17, 2014. The parties have discussed the case and the Tribe believes the case should be set for Trial. The Tribe stated that there are some outstanding motions that need to be addressed before the Trial hearing. Defense counsel stated that the Defendant would like to set the matter for trial hearing. The parties gave their arguments regarding speedy trial time limits in this case and that the speedy trial time limits expire on July 30, 2014. The Court finds that due to extenuating circumstances regarding the setting of a bench trial in this matter the Bench Trial hearing for this matter will be set for August 7, 2014 at 9:00 a.m..

The parties addressed the outstanding Motion to Dismiss and the parties both agreed to submit the issue to the Court on the pleadings. The Court will issue an order on the Defendant's Motion to Dismiss on July 21, 2014. The Tribe will be required to file a writ for the Defendant to appear before this Court for his bench trial hearing.

IT IS ORDERED that the matter will be set for Bench Trial hearing on **AUGUST 4, 2014 AT 9:00 A.M.** The Tribe shall file a writ to allow for the Defendant to personally appear before this Court for his bench trial hearing.
