To whom it may concern:

I Paul Gonzales, the respondent of case number: OP-14-031, would like to have this restraining order appealed. The restraining order states that I (The Respondent) went to Clariza Madrid (the Petitioner's) home, hurt my daughter (Ariyah Zaraey Roze Gonzales), and that Clariza Madrid (The Petitioner) took her from Paul Gonzales (The Respondent) and made Paul Gonzales (The Respondent) leave. The restraining order also states that Paul Gonzales (The Respondent) called Clariza Madrid (The Petitioner) repeatedly, leaving messages from different numbers and Paul Gonzales (The Respondent) constantly harassed Clariza Madrid (The Petitioner). Paul Gonzales (The Respondent) uses mother to get through to Clariza Madrid (The Petitioner), and Paul Gonzales (The Respondent) shows up unannounced and keeps calling CPS.

The several acts that the petitioner states that occurred, considers me as being a threat to the petitioner and minor children. I Paul Gonzales disagree, there was never a time I showed up at Clariza Madrid's home unannounced. I have always messaged her and let her know when I was coming, except the day of July 19, 2014 when I went to her residence to clean my daughter (Ariyah Zaraey Roze Gonzales) mouth. Clariza Madrid let me inside her home, woke up my daughter, and handed her to me so I can brush her teeth. I looked in her mouth and seen blisters and inflamed gums. Clariza Madrid told me the doctor was unaware of what it was and didn't say parents could not clean her mouth.

I used a soft brisel, Childrens toothbrush and peroxide sore mouth cleanser to clean my daughter's mouth. While I was cleaning my daughter's mouth, Ariyah Zaraey Roze Gonzales, did cry. However, Clariza Madrid did allow



me to finish. Together, we put her toothbrush in a plastic bag and I told Clariza Madrid to use only that tooth brush and the sore mouth cleanser to clean Ariyah Zaraey Roze Gonzale's mouth until the blisters are gone. I told her there is a possible chance it may be gingivitis and that gingivitis may have caused the infection. I told Clariza Madrid I have had this infection before and this is what I used to get rid of the infection. I asked Jazmine Mahleya Madril, my other daughter who is in the first grade, if her mother Clariza Madrid brush's her teeth. Jazmine has crowns in her mouth and cavities. Jazmine said no, she brushes her teeth herself. I also told Clariza Madrid that the reason Ariyah may have gingivitis is because Clariza Madrid, the mother, doesn't brush her teeth. Clariza Madrid got upset and she said that I could not see my children. I did not argue. I just left. As soon as I left, I called the police to check the residence my children are currently living. I told Officer Pallanes, Badge number: 3L54, that I felt my children were not being properly taken care of and I want a CPS case so I can start the steps of getting custody of my Children.

The officer checked her home, made a report and a CPS worker started the case. I called Clariza Madrid from my mother's phone to let her know that I will be over the next day, July 20, 2014, with a police escort to clean Ariyah Zaraey Roze Gonzales mouth. All she said was to never call her again and then proceeded to hang up on me.

In conclusion, I am not a danger to my children as the petitioner states. I was only worried and tried to help my daughter, Ariyah Zaraey Roze Gonzales. Since a month prior to July 19, 2014 I have not been allowed to see my daughters at all. Clariza Madrid didn't allow visitation. So you can probably see why I got worried. Clariza Madrid told me the only reason she put a restraining order on me was because the CPS worker was not going to close her case if she didn't. As a result, Clariza Madrid does not believe I am a danger to her or my children as well.
