

On November 17, 2022, the above matter came before the Court on a Petition for Dissolution of Marriage. The Petitioner, Gloria Gomez, appeared. The Respondent, Ernesto Gomez, failed to appear.

The Court notes that the Defendant was not properly served with the date of today's hearing. The Court informed the Petitioner that the Respondent will need to be served. The Court also notes that the Petitioner did provide proof of service of the actual Petition for Dissolution of Marriage and now she needs to do the same as to the date of the hearing. The Court found good cause to continue the hearing so that the Respondent can be properly served with the date of the next hearing.

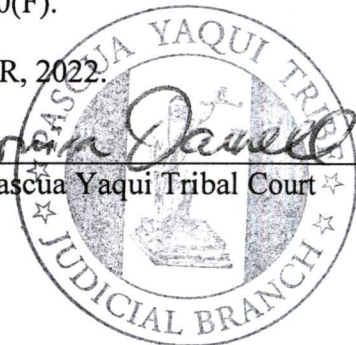
IT IS ORDERED that the Hearing on the Petition for Dissolution of Marriage is continued to THURSDAY, DECEMBER 29, 2022, AT 9:00 A.M.

IT IS ORDERED that the Petitioner shall provide a notice by publication to the Respondent, Ernesto Gomez, to be published pursuant to the Pascua Yaqui Tribal Code. **The publication notice shall provide the Respondent with Notice of Hearing on the Petition for Dissolution of Marriage. It must provide "the name of the court, name of the child[ren], the date of the filing of the petition, . . . , and the object of the proceeding in general terms,"**

The Petitioner shall file with the Court Clerk an affidavit and publisher's certificate showing publication of the notice pursuant to 3 PYTC 2-6-280(F).
